Building Schools that Support Innovative Learning

Over the past decade, WPS has invested in:

- Building the state-of-the-art Westminster High School.
 Two high-quality performance arts spaces and a modern theater enable the school to have a thriving, award-winning performing arts program.
- Building Hodgkins Elementary school, a modern building to support a thriving neighborhood community.
- Renovating John E. Flynn A Marzano Academy, home to one of the most innovative schools in the state.
- Renovating Harris Park Elementary School so that the look of the building reflects the quality instruction.
- Creating a forward-thinking and health-conscious nutrition program.
- Building an industrial kitchen at Hidden Lake High School so graduating culinary students can step into professional careers.
- Expanding the Career Technical Education (CTE) Program, enabling students to graduate with job-ready skills in the construction and trade industries.
- Maintaining safe, comfortable environments so that students can focus on learning. Major initiatives included: replacing 13 roofs, installing new air conditioning and heating systems at 8 schools, and installing safety upgrades in all buildings.

Leading Innovation

WPS creates personalized learning opportunities which enable ALL students to develop the skills and knowledge required to achieve their dreams.

Over the past decade, WPS has:

- Led the national movement toward Competency Based Learning Systems. This innovative vision for public education ends social promotion by requiring students to master their learning content and only advance when ready.
- Created three innovation schools, each with a specialized approach – Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math (STEM); Westminster Academy for International Studies (WAIS); and the Marzano Academy.
- Developed a Creative Arts Pipeline for students to turn their passion of the arts into career opportunities.
- Invested in a virtual academy to create anywhere, anytime online learning opportunities.
- Expanded Early Childhood learning programs across the district to ensure kindergarten readiness.
- Delivered high-quality one-on-one teacher time for students by reducing class sizes in K-1.
- Invested in staff and curriculum materials to meet the language and academic needs of all students, including English Language Learners.
